







Substance Abuse	If parent is impacted by alcohol, mental health, or substance abuse and has children 0-5 years old. Desires to improve parenting and acquire treatment.	Operation Par	
	If pregnant woman or parent of child less than three and alcohol or drug use/misuse is present.	PAT +	
First Child	If a first time pregnant mother, low income, and less than 28 weeks gestation.	Pinellas Nurse-Family Partnership	
School Readiness	If parent of a child age 0-5 years old (prefer under 16 months), not in child care, and lives north of Ulmerton Road. Must be available for home visits. Income at or below 150% of FPL.	Florida First Start	
	If a parent/guardian of a 3 or 4 year old child. Income less than 200% FPL and resides in 33755, 33756, 33760, 33781, 33705, 33709, 33711, 33712, 33713, 33714. Exceptions with income.	HIPPY	
	If pregnant or parent of a child under age 3. Income must be at or less than FPL or be a current TANF recipient or a recipient within a year of application. Transportation available. Must show documentation of work or attending school full-time.	Early Head Start	
Parent/Child Relationship	If pregnant or parent of a newborn less than 90 days old. Will be screened by Healthy Families Florida Assessment Tool to be eligible.	Healthy Families Pinellas	
	If prenatal woman, woman of children bearing age, or parent of an infant under age 2. Primarily serves African American community living in 33705, 33711, 33712, 33713.	Healthy Start Federal Project	
	If parent of child age 0-5 on child welfare, has mental health or substance abuse needs, domestic violence, child developmentally at risk or with behavioral/emotional needs.	Total Family Strategy	
	If pregnant woman or parent of an infant age 0-3 scoring at risk on the Healthy Start Prenatal or Infant Screening Tool (Prenatal 6 or more, Infant 4 or more).	Florida Healthy Start	
	If under 6 months pregnant & has either no health insurance, in high school, high risk pregnancy, no transportation or support and lives between Park Blvd and Tarpon Avenue.	Good Start = Good Life	
Developmental Delays	If parent has a child age 0-3 years showing developmental delays or a condition that results in delays.	West Central Early Steps	
	If a parent of a child age 0-6 years who is showing developmental delays or at risk of developmental delays.	PARC	
	If a parent of a child age 0-5 years old with a mental illness/mental condition. Available for in-home care.	Therapeutic Preschool Intervention Program	
Behavioral and Emotional Needs	If a parent of a child age 0-5 years with behavior/emotional needs and wants training on how to care for child with these needs.	Early Childhood Consultation	
	If parent of a child age 4-17 with severe behavioral/emotional needs and want to remove them from an inpatient setting.	In-Home On-Site
